The Clarinet Parts

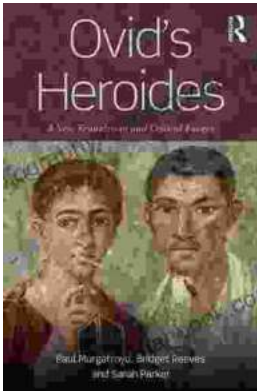
