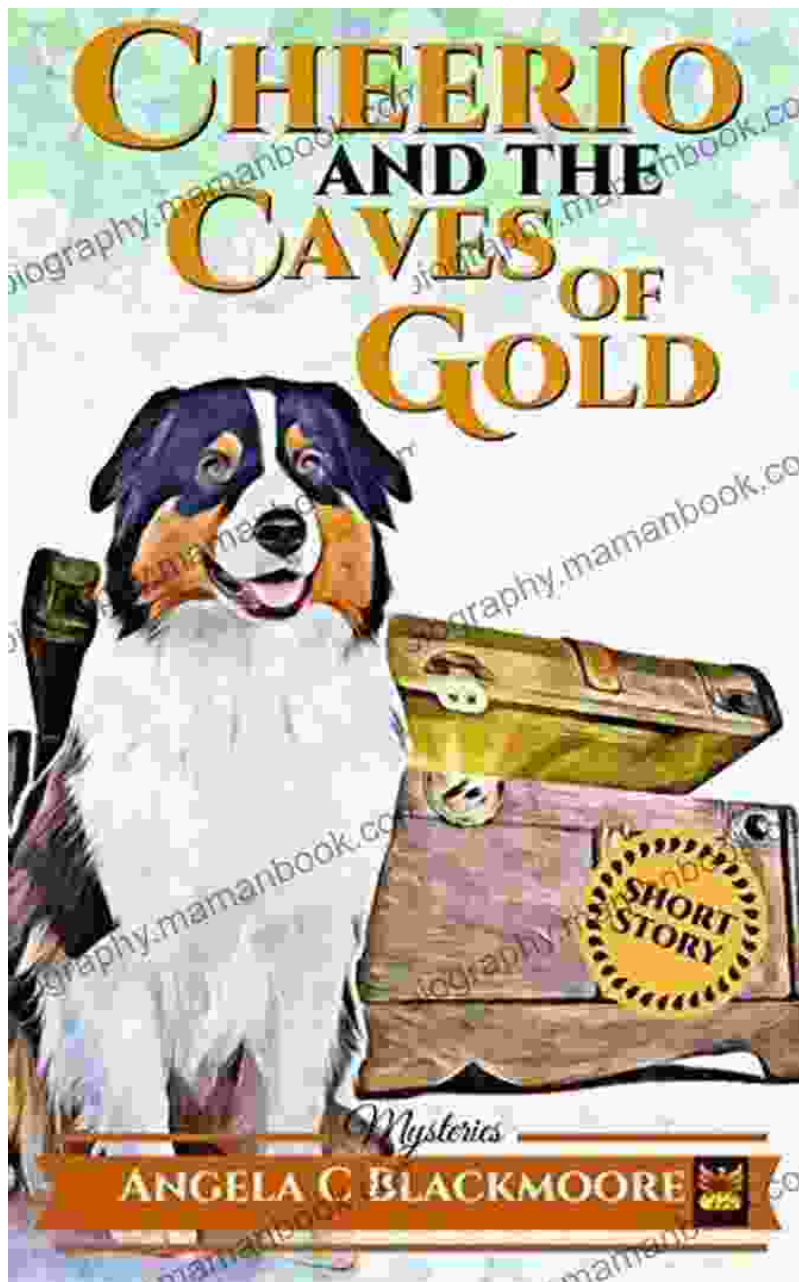


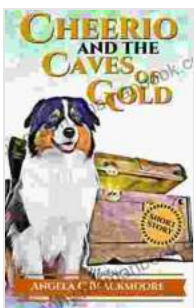
Cheerio and the Caves of Gold: A Magical Adventure in Red Pine Falls

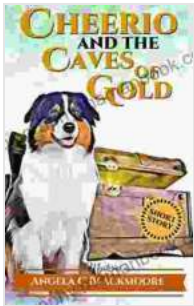

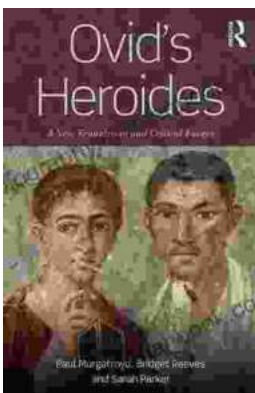
