- 4. Rnd 3-8: Rep Rnd 2.
- 5. **Rnd 9:** Ch 3, dc in the next dc, *hdc in the next dc, sc in the next dc, rep from * around. Join with a sl st to the first dc.
- 6. Rnd 10-13: Rep Rnd 9.
- 7. **Rnd 14:** Change to Color B. Ch 3, dc in the next dc, *hdc in the next dc, dc in the next 2 dc, rep from * around. Join with a sl st to the first dc.
- 8. **Rnd 15-18:** Rep Rnd 14.
- 9. **Rnd 19:** Change to Color A. Ch 3, dc in the next dc, *hdc in the next dc, sc in the next 2 dc, rep from * around. Join with a sl st to the first dc.
- 10. **Rnd 20-23:** Rep Rnd 19.
- 11. **Rnd 24:** Change to Color B. Ch 3, dc in the next dc, *hdc in the next dc, dc in the next 3 dc, rep from * around. Join with a sl st to the first dc.

- 12. Rnd 25-28: Rep Rnd 24.
- 13. **Rnd 29:** Change to Color A. Ch 3, dc in the next dc, *hdc in the next dc, sc in the next 3 dc, rep from * around. Join with a sl st to the first dc.
- 14. **Rnd 30-33:** Rep Rnd 29.
- 15. **Rnd 34:** Change to Color B. Ch 3, dc in the next dc, *hdc in the next dc, dc in the next 4 dc, rep from * around. Join with a sl st to the first dc.
- 16. **Rnd 35-38:** Rep Rnd 34.
- 17. **Rnd 39:** Change to Color A. Ch 3, dc in the next dc, *hdc in the next dc, sc in the next 4 dc, rep from * around. Join with a sl st to the first dc.
- 18. Rnd 40-43: Rep Rnd 39.
- 19. **Rnd 44:** Change to Color B. Ch 3, dc in the next dc, *hdc in the next dc, dc in the next 5 dc, rep from * around. Join with a sl st to the first dc.
- 20. Rnd 45-48: Rep Rnd 44.
- 21. **Rnd 49:** Change to Color A. Ch 3, dc in the next dc, *hdc in the next dc, sc in the next 5 dc, rep from * around. Join with a sl st to the first dc.
- 22. **Rnd 50-53:** Rep Rnd 49.
- 23. **Rnd 54:** Ch 3, dc in the next dc, *hdc in the next dc, dc in the next 6 dc, rep from * around. Join with a sl st to the first dc.
- 24. Rnd 55-56: Change to Color B. Rep Rnd 54.

25. Fasten off and weave in loose ends.

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
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
